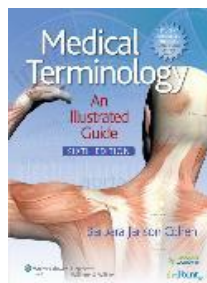


Learn to speak the language. What does Hypertension or Epistaxis mean??
